## Important Parent Reminders

1. All registration fees and immunizations (including Hep-A) records for your child must be up-to-date. If these requirements are not met, then Youth Activities will discontinue services to your child until requirements are met.
2. If your child is sick (especially if it is contagious), services for your child will be discontinued until we have a doctor's notice back saying they are clear to attend our facility again.
3. If a child is being picked up by someone other than the parent(s), we require them to be on our authorization list that is filled out when they first register. If the person is not on the parent authorization list, we will NOT release your child to that person.
4. The cap for Furloughs is currently 45 children. All drop-ins must register for Non-School Day field trips in the Youth Activities front office. We cannot accept over 45 children on Non-School Days, so please do not just drop your child off on the day of a non school day, because we will not be able to accept them if space is not available.
